

The April meeting of the Cady Town Board was held on Monday, April 5, 2010 at 8 p.m. at the town hall. Attending were Brain Wang and Richard Benjamin.

Chairman Tully called the meeting to order. Motion was made by Supervisor Timm and second by Supervisor Hampton to accept the March minutes as read. Motion was passed.

Nick Jenkins from Rural Mutual Insurance discussed the municipality coverage. Supervisor Timm and Clerk Greiber will get current equipment values to Jenkins. After some discussion, a motion was made by Chairman Tully and second by Supervisor Timm to sign a waiver for the additional underinsured/uninsured motorist coverage. Motion was passed.

Bills were reviewed and paid.

Chairman Tully and Supervisors Hampton and Timm gave Clerk Greiber their Affidavit of Attendance forms for Board of Review Training attended March 26, 2010 in Eau Claire.

Clerk Greiber told the board that UW-River Falls Archives took all Town documents earlier than 1900; all financial information to 1968 and assessment records (every 5th year) to 1950. After 1950 they have records from the county.

Chairman Tully explained what he had found when talking to Continental Computer Recycling. A motion was made by Chairman Tully and second by Supervisor Hampton to sign a contract changing the language to read "start April 1, 2010 and allow the contract to be terminated by either party at anytime." Motion was passed. CCR will bring a box to the Town Recycling Shed to put items in that can be torn apart and recycled.

Road signs were discussed. All signs need to meet reflectivity standards by 2015. Wayne will do a sign inventory. All signs now purchased will need to meet the new standards.

Discussion was held on prevailing wage.

A motion was made by Supervisor Timm and second by Chairman Tully to purchase a disk to use on the road shoulders. The cost would be \$4104. Motion was passed.

May meeting will be May 3, 2010.

Motion to adjourn was made by Supervisor Hampton, second by Supervisor Timm. Motion passed.
